MEDLOCK SCHOLARSHIP \$1000

2. plan to student teach within the next year (may include students who are currently student teaching).
3. have completed or in the process of completing all education course work during the semester applying for the award.
4. submit passing scores for Praxis I.
5. submit a one-page teaching philosophy statement. (put into a folder with work April 3rd)
6. submit a statement regarding financial need. (put into a folder with work April 3rd)

YOES SCHOLARSHIP \$1000

Student must:

1. have a 2.5 or above GPA.
2. be a junior or a senior in the fall 2009 semester.
3. be employed and earning money for college.
4. be an Arkansas resident.
